

Primary 1 - Summer Term, 2022

Overview

 <p>Communication (tracking and motor skills)</p>	<p>This term pupils are exploring sensory texts such as Handa's Surprise. They will be exploring the characters in the story and all the fruits they collect. Pupils will develop their fine motor and pre-writing skills linked to the stories we read. Pupils will also be engaging in interesting and fun activities designed to develop their tracking skills.</p>
 <p>Number, Space, Space and Measure.</p>	<p>In our Shape, Space and Measure topic pupils are exploring Night and Day. They will be exploring the events of a day and routines that link to night time. Sequencing events and anticipating what comes next.</p> <p>In Number work pupils are investigating all things number, through rhymes, songs and engaging practical activities. Pupils will develop their understanding of the sequence of number and explore objects of interest related to number.</p>
 <p>Let's Investigate</p>	<p>This term pupils are exploring bubbles. They will compare sizes of different bubbles. We will encourage pupils to interact with the bubbles. We will be making different mixtures using different soaps and detergents to find out which make the best bubbles.</p>
 <p>Our World</p>	<p>This term pupils are developing their understanding and awareness of what is around them. They will explore the school, and the important places within it. Pupils will also be noticing when things change around school, flowers blooming, and furniture changing and new people.</p>
 <p>Creative Arts and Design</p>	<p>In Art this term we are looking at collage linked to fruit and vegetables, which also links to our sensory story. Pupils will be exploring texture, colour and shapes of fruit. This also provides opportunity to explore and use our senses such as smell and taste.</p> <p>In Design and Make pupils will be making shoe box gardens. They will explore the natural materials found in gardens, noticing the different textures, sizes and smells.</p>
 <p>PSHE</p>	<p>In PSHE this term pupils will be exploring people who help us. Initially pupils are looking at who are in their classes and around the school who help us. Then they will develop their understanding of people in the community such as firefighters, police, nurses and doctors through role play and fun activities using the sensory suit.</p>



Music

This term we are exploring African music. Pupils will be listening to music from around Africa, responding through movements and dancing. They will also explore different types of instruments from tuned to shaking and scraping.



Physical Education

This term pupils will be exploring playgrounds and the skills required to use them such as climbing, running and sliding. We will be encouraging pupils to fully use equipment in playgrounds in school and in the local community. Pupils will also be taking part in games and sharing activities. Alongside our Physical Education lessons there will also be sessions for Rebound and Aquatic learning.
